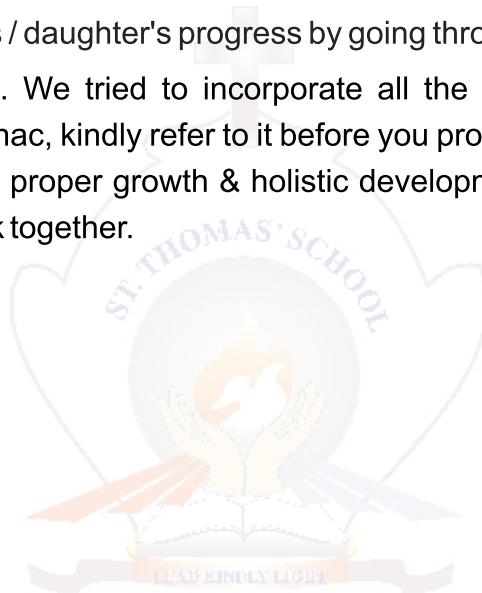

ADMISSION

1. Although a minority institution, we do admit children of different castes and creeds.
2. All applications for admission have to be made in writing on the form obtained from the school office.
3. No child of less than 3 years 00 months and more than 3 years 11 months will be admitted to Nursery. For higher classes add one year for each class.
4. A pupil seeking admission must produce the Date of Birth Certificate issued by the concerned govt. authorities along with the Transfer Certificate and aadhaar card, if applicable.
5. Irrespective of the time of admission, fee will be charged from the beginning of the academic session.
6. All documents, once submitted, become the property of the school and are not returned.
7. Date of birth once registered will not be altered. Date of Birth certificate issued by the registrar of Birth's & Death's only is the valid document. Aadhaar card is not the valid proof of Date of Birth (Honour Supreme Court October 24,2024).

WITHDRAWAL

1. The application for Transfer Certificate should be made in writing by the parent or guardian along with prescribed fee.
2. At least One full academic session must be completed for obtaining a T.C.
3. During an academic session a month's notice in writing is required before a student can be withdrawn; an additional fee of one month may be deposited. No such notice is acceptable during the school vacation; and in case of a withdrawal at this time, the fees must be paid up to the end of the quarter.
4. Application for Transfer certificate should be submitted within 03 months in case student leave without taking TC
5. No Transfer Certificate or any other Certificate will be issued if there are dues pending.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

1. Irregular attendance at school, habitual laziness, disobedience, objectionable moral influence, intentional discourtesy or disrespect to teachers, are each sufficient cause for dismissal.
2. Any student who is found to have done damage of any kind in the class room or anywhere in the premises of the School has to make good the damage done.
3. All should be particularly careful to avoid throwing of food, papers etc. anywhere in the School premises except in the bins provided for the purpose.
4. No late arrival to School may be admitted to class without the Principal's or PTI's signature on the late attendance Record page in the School Dairy. The teachers will also sign the Absence Record Page before admitting the pupil to class.
5. No pupil may leave the school premises during school hours (recess time included) without the written permission from the Principal.
6. The School is not responsible for the loss of books, pens, money etc. Each student is responsible for his/her things.
7. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles like watches, Gold/silver ornaments, etc. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones.
8. Each student's belongings must be marked, as far as possible, with the owner's name for easy identification.
9. Books & copies must be properly covered and not torn out.
10. Students indulge in misconduct or indiscipline will be debarred from Class picnics, competitions and other classroom activities.

SYLLABUS / EXAMINATION / PROMOTION

1. Besides the Terminal Examinations there are other Tests during the year. Report on conduct, application and progress and attendance are furnished from time to time to the parents/guardians to keep them informed about the performance of their children in School.

2. Pupil absent from the Examination or Test for any reason, is not re-examined, and loses the marks. If they are absent without grave reasons- or previous written permission they will be regarded as having failed.
3. If a pupil does not have 75% of attendance she/he will not allowed to write exam and not be considered for promotion.
4. The Progress Report/Result will be shown only to the parents or guardians after every Term examination; it can be withheld for non-payment of school dues.
5. Failure in or absence from a subject excludes the student from being reckoned for the order of merit.
6. Taking all the term exams is compulsory for promotion.
7. There is no provision for Re-examination or promotion on trial.
8. No examination will be postponed or anticipated for any student.
9. There is no double promotion to any student to any class.
10. For Promotion, a student has to obtain clear pass in major subjects. Pass percentage for students Kindergarten : 50% Class - I to V : 40% VI and above 33%

The academic year is divided into two terms. Students are evaluated through formal assessments as well as through their day performance under the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE). Formal assessments are held at the end of each term. Four formal assessments are conducted in the academic session:

- Unit Test-1 (UT 1) included the entire syllabus covered till the test date.
- Half yearly Examination (HE) is cumulative in nature and includes the entire syllabus of Term -1.
- Unit Test-2 (UT 2) includes the syllabus covered post term-1 till the test date.
- Annual Examination (AE) is cumulative in nature and will be based on selected portion from Term -1 and the entire syllabus of Term -2.

FEE RULES

1. School fees are to be paid for full year, i.e for all twelve months.
2. All fees to be remitted at the SCHOOL ONLINE PAYMENT PORTAL or at Specified branch of Bank, written in the fee book.
3. No fee transaction will be accepted in the school either as cash or cheque.
4. Parents should retain the receipts issued to them, and produce them as proof of payment if and when needed.
5. The fees must be paid for the months in which the pupil's name has been carried on in the attendance register, even if he/she has been absent.
6. The Quarterly fee has to be paid in full, even if the pupil leaves before the Quarter is over. The Sequence of the quarter should be followed strictly.
7. Students whose fees fall into arrears are liable to be debarred from taking the exams and attending school; neither their Report Cards nor Transfer Certificates will be issued till all accounts are fully settled.
9. No reduction in fees is made on account of Summer and Winter holidays or other vacations or temporary absence. School fees are calculated for a twelve month cycle.
10. No concession in fees is entertained in any case especially for three or more children coming from the same family or single girl child, etc.
11. All certificates other than T.C. and Migration Certificate can be had for minimum Rs.100/- each per certificate.
12. The fees may be paid in advance for a quarter. If not paid in advance, the fees of the running quarter will have to be paid before the end of the first month of that quarter after which a fine of Rs.300/- will be levied for late payment for each passing month.
13. There will be proportionate increment in the fees every year as per the UP Self-financed independent school (Fee Regulatory) Act 2018.
14. Annual composite fee is an all-inclusive fee except exam fee. The School will collect additional charges for optional items such as picnics, special activities programmes, costumes for events and performances, props and materials.

PUNCTUALITY AND ATTENDANCE

1. Regularity in attendance is most essential. The minimum requirement of attendance is 75%.
2. Students must report to school on time.
3. Parents should fill the school leave record for each day the student is absent from school stating the reason for absence.
4. No student who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the filled leave record signed. Ref. Page No. 50 & 63
5. Students are not allowed to go home once they come to the school in the morning. Appointment with doctors or any social engagements must not be arranged during school hours. No partial attendance will be permitted.
6. No student is permitted to leave school before time except on emergency health issues and other family exigencies, students will not be sent with anyone else other than parents, unless an application to the contrary with adequate identify proof by the parents, is submitted
7. Repeated absence without permission or unexplained absence for more than eight consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only after payment of a re-admission fee at the discretion of the principal.
8. The student who does not rejoin the school within three days after the commencement of a Term or a major vacation shall be removed from the rolls unless leave has been previously applied for and sanctioned by the principal.
9. Marriage, Tours, Family function, etc. and any pre-planned programme, you are recommended to submit a leave application in advance in a separate paper other than school diary.
10. In case of absence for more than three days on medical grounds, a medical-certificate must be produced. The medical certificate should bear the rubber stamp of the doctor with the registration number. In case if necessary, the school has the right to have the child re-examined by a doctor acceptable to the school

**P.T. UNIFORM TO BE WORN ON
EVERY WEDNESDAY & SATURDAY**

1. All shirts, T-shirts, sweaters and blazers should have accurate school crest on the pocket area.
2. Students without proper uniform and personal hygiene will not be allowed to sit in the class.
3. Students must wear their Identity Card everyday.
4. Students must carry a handkerchief and a napkin to school. No gold jewelry is to be worn to school.
5. House shoes should be worn for games, yoga and P.T.

Corporal Punishment :

Corporal punishment is an act intended to cause physical pain on a person. It is most often inflicted on minors, especially at home or school. However, it is often used as a tool by teachers to cane, slap, spank pinch or any other form of physical violence in order to discipline students. Corporal punishment includes making the student to stand on a desk/bench/chair or stand outside the class for longer period or to force the student to do sit ups, insulting or humiliating in front of the companions.

Any form so Corporal punishment is strictly forbidden in the school; if any teacher is using corporal punishment be comfortable to meet the principal or sent a letter of grievance to the email ID of the principal.

COOPERATION FROM PARENTS

1. Please read and understand the contents of this diary and doubts (if any) can be cleared from the school.
2. These Rules and Regulations are laid down in the best interest of your child. Kindly read them and assist your child to observe them diligently.
3. Give your whole-hearted and willing cooperation in all matters pertaining to the education of your child. Please abide by the judgment and decision of the Principal and Staff.
4. Supervise your child's studies at home; send him/her to school regularly. And help him/her to maintain school work neatly.
5. Do look for the occasional reports, comments and complaints from teachers entered in the diary of your child; sign them as proof that you have seen them; and also sign other relevant documents when required.
6. In matters of evaluating the answer sheets and the annual promotions, the opinion of the Principal and the faculty is binding.
7. Answer sheets of the Half yearly Examination will be shown to you for scrutiny on the day of the Report Card. This provision is made only to assess the performance of your child and hence, no corrections or re- evaluation of answer sheets will be entertained under any circumstance. In case of failure to collect Report card on due date, Rs. 50/- per day will be collected for each passing day.
8. The principal may correct a student in a manner suited to the seriousness or frequency of the offence, which may vary from detention after school hours to suspension, or even expulsion from the school.
9. Please do not support the small lies of the children; it will lead to bigger ones later. You must Love them, but not without teaching them responsibility.
10. Children are your wealth; students are our pride. As you love and care for them, so do we, and intend the best for them. Hence we the teachers and parents should have mutual trust and confidence.
11. Very often students bring to school such items that have nothing to do with studies. Parents must prevent the children from bringing such things to the

school. Please do not expect the Principal and the teachers to do what the parents are supposed to do.

12. It is matter of deep concern that parents send children suffering from infectious ailments to attend classes or examinations. Such conduct would lead to an epidemic like situation in the school. Take note of the quarantine period recommended for a few different infectious ailments:
 - a. Chicken Pox - three weeks
 - b. Measles and mumps-two weeks
 - c. Conjunctivitis - one week
13. Late arrival in the school and leave of absence should be informed in writing.
14. No gifts to staff and students in the name of birthday celebrations. Please keep this to the lowest key possible. Parents must refrain from sending gifts to teachers on any occasion.
15. No Student is permitted to bring or distribute toffee / chocolates / wafers / chewings gums/Fries/Cold Drink/Packed Chips etc. on any occasion.
16. Healthy and nutritious food should be packed for tiffin along with a napkin. No fast food and junk food allowed in the school. No lunch boxes will be accepted during the school time. Please follow the menu provided from the school.
17. School will not provide any conveyance and will not have any responsibility on any eventuality.
18. Students are not allowed to come to school riding bicycles/ two wheelers without the explicit permission of the principal.
19. Students' bicycle must be locked and parked in the cycle stand.
20. Parents should ensure that their ward report to school before the morning assembly begins and pick up the child only after the school hours are over. No cars or any other mode of transport will be permitted to be parked in front of the school gates.
21. Please check the almanac each day for entries from the school and also use the almanac for any communication with the school.
22. Ensure strict adherence to the prescribed uniforms, cleanliness and personal hygiene of your ward.

23. See that all required text/note books and stationery are carried each day to the school as per time table.
24. Check if homework or other assignments are completed as required.
25. Parents should furnish to school their latest office and residential addresses and telephone numbers. These are vital in the interest of the safety of the student.
26. No money is to be given for events organized by the school unless asked through official circular.
27. The name of the student, class and section must be marked on all personal belongings to facilitate recovery if lost in the school premises.
28. Parents of pre-primary must write the names of their wards on their belongings with a permanent marker. They should also send an extra set of clothes in their bags to be used in case of emergency.
29. Under no circumstances parents are allowed to directly walk to the classrooms. They need to have prior appointment for any genuine reasons to meet the teachers only in the visitors lounge.
30. The school strongly discourages private tuitions. The teaching program in the school is good enough for the students to perform well, provided they are attentive in the class and realize their responsibilities. The habit of self-study and regularity in reading must be encouraged at home.
31. Parents should keep in mind as co-educators of the child, it is very essential to observe the dress code when they are in the school premises. Pedal-pushers, Bermuda shorts or any tight fitting or suggestive clothing could be a source of distraction or deviation from the normal dress code. Public with indecent and inappropriate dress code will not be permitted in the school premises.
32. Carrying or Eating Gutka, Paan or smoking inside the school premises are strictly forbidden.
33. Shooting of photos, videos inside the school building without permission from the Principal is prohibited.

12. Birthday celebrations should be restricted to your section only and to the minimum show.

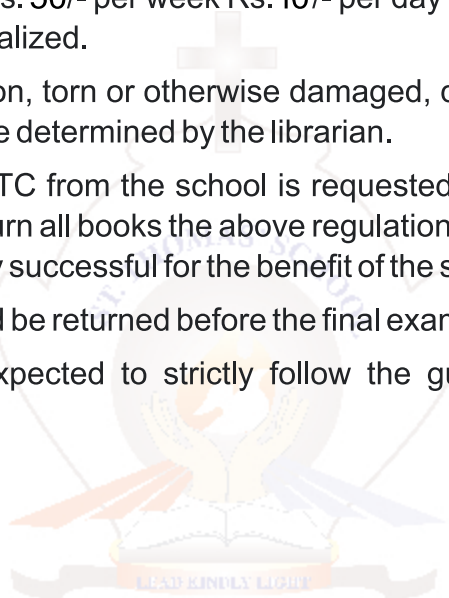
EXPULSION FROM SCHOOL

Irregularity, careless and untidy work in academics, lack of punctuality, failure of the student to be in proper school uniform consistently, any act of misconduct or bad behavior and/ or dissatisfactory performance may lead to suspension from school for a period of time depending on the degree of non- conformance. Repeated non- conformance may lead to rustication from the school. Anecdotal records of students are maintained by the school. The non-compliance, non-cooperative and quarrelsome attitude of the parents towards the school management and faculty is a valid reason for rustication of their ward/s from school

RULES OF LIBRARY

1. The student must maintain silence in the library.
2. Every student will hold one card which is not transferable. A book may be issued for one week at a time but the students should return the book within a week; otherwise a fine is levied.
3. Duplicate card will not be issued on a payment of Rs. 50/-
4. Every student should return the card before the session ends.
5. A book can be re issued only once.
6. Every class has a day on which the books will be issued; it is compulsory for every student to read books from library.

7. Students can return the book during library period and students who want to borrow a book should fill up the entries on their cards and leave them with the librarian. They can collect the book from the library during the library period. There will be an overdue charge of rupees 5/- per day per book if a book is kept longer than the specified period.
8. The loss or damage to the book will be realized along with the special fine.
9. Only one volume can be borrowed at a time. Periodicals and reference books are not issued.
10. Books taken for home must be returned on the date within two weeks otherwise a fine of Rs. 50/- per week Rs. 10/- per day will have to be paid until the cost of book is realized.
11. Books scribbled upon, torn or otherwise damaged, defaced or lost must be paid for at a rate to be determined by the librarian.
12. Student who takes TC from the school is requested to clear his/her library dues in time and return all books the above regulations are made to make the working of the library successful for the benefit of the students.
13. Books issued should be returned before the final exam.
14. Every student is expected to strictly follow the guidelines given by the librarian.

10. Do not scribble on the walls and books.
11. Switch off the fans, lights and close the taps after use.

HELP TO STUDY

Anti-Bullying and Anti-Ragging Policy

Our Commitment :

What is Bullying/Ragging?

- **Ragging** refers to any act of teasing, humiliating, or harassing a student, often under the pretext of "fun" or "tradition". especially targeting newcomers.
- **Physical Bullying** : Hitting, pushing, tripping, or damaging personal property.
- **Verbal Bullying** : Name-calling, taunting, intimidating, or spreading rumours.
- **Social/Relational Bullying** : Excluding others from a group, spreading gossip, or damaging reputations.
- **Cyberbullying** : Using digital platforms (social media, texting, emails etc.) to harm or intimidate others.
- **Racial, Religious, or Homophobic Bullying** : Bullying based on a student's race, ethnicity, religion, physical features or sexual orientation.

Our Policy :

1. **Zero Tolerance** : Any form of bullying or ragging will result in disciplinary action, which may include warnings, counseling, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity.
